



Interments FY24 YTD




Cash Benefits Received into Missouri Economy to Direct Cost for MVC Veterans Service Program








Missouri Veteran Population (2021)




CUSTOMER SATISFACTION MISSOURI VETERANS HOME AVERAGE MISSOURI VETERANS HOME

percentage that rated Recommend to Others as a 4 or 5.










Flow Chart for Recreational Marijuana

Revenues

- 6% Sales Tax
- Associated Fees
- Miscellaneous (Interest gained by the fund, etc.)

Veterans, Health, and Community Reinvestment Fund (0608)

- Department of Revenue retains two percent of the total tax collected or its actual collection costs, whichever is less
- First priority of spending: To DHSS to carry out program
- Second priority of spending: To governmental entities in amounts necessary for carrying out expungement of criminal history records (Judiciary, Highway Patrol)
